## **Dr. DeCaprio Biography:**

Dr. Anthony DeCaprio is a toxicologist with extensive research experience in neurotoxicology and the analysis of drugs, environmental contaminants, and other xenobiotics in human specimens. He has published more than 80 peer-reviewed research articles and book chapters in addition to editing the book “Toxicologic Biomarkers”. He previously worked as a Research Scientist with the New York State Department of Health Wadsworth Laboratories, where he directed research projects on the molecular mechanism of action of occupational neurotoxicants. Prior to joining FIU in 2009 as Associate Professor in Chemistry & Biochemistry, Dr. DeCaprio served in academic positions in Environmental Health Sciences at UAlbany and UMass Amherst. While at UAlbany, he directed a large human biomonitoring program as part of an NIEHS-funded Superfund program focusing on polychlorinated biphenyl exposure in a Native American population in New York State. Dr. DeCaprio currently directs the Forensic & Analytical Toxicology Facility (FATF) at FIU, a core lab facility

that provides research support and services to FIU and other investigators in the area of analytical/clinical/forensic toxicology. Dr. DeCaprio has been PI on grants from NIEHS, NCI, NIOSH, ATSDR, and the National Institute of Justice.
